

LUHI CIT DAILY SCHEDULE

9:00 – 9:30: CIT'S arrive on campus and are assigned to front barrier duty. CIT's help direct campers where to go and help supervise camper safety.

9:30 – 9:45: CIT's meet with CIT director. CIT's are assigned a program to work with for the day. This is done during the first week of the program.

9:45 – 10:10: CIT's meet a "director of the day". Directors of the various LuHi programs discuss their programs and what they expect from their counselors.

10:15 – 3:00: CIT's are dismissed to their scheduled group. They spend the remainder of the day with their assigned group, working and helping LuHi camp counselors. Also during this time CIT's are trained in CPR.

3:00 – 3:45: CIT's are assigned front barrier duty in front of camp or work the sign-out table at the Nurse's Station. Some CIT's stay with their groups and help assist counselors escort younger campers to their buses.

3:45: CIT's are dismissed to their buses.
